Is your goal to encourage social responsibility and community service for your students? We organize packing events where students assemble fortified soy/rice casserole-style meals specifically formulated to meet the nutritional needs of starving children. Boxes of meals are currently being distributed to humanitarian organizations worldwide including , Haiti and the Philippines,. Meals are also stored at the Alameda County Fairgrounds Regional Disaster Recovery Center to be used in the event of a local emergency or disaster.

- ◆ Volunteers as young as 2nd grade are encouraged to participate and families are welcomed too.
- ◆ For every \$20 your student donates, 100 children are fed.
- ◆ A packing event is typically two hours and can be scheduled weekdays, evenings or weekends.
- ◆ Kids Against Hunger packing events can be as small as ten people or as large as your imagination. For a minimum donation of \$2,000, we can bring the packing event to your school.

What do you need to book a packing event at your school?

- ◆ Minimum of 100 people (including students & adults)
- ◆ Space to accommodate workers.
- ◆ Tables (4 people per 6 foot table).
- ◆ Easy access for our truck to unload ingredients and reload packaged meals.
